

## PLEASE USE THE FOLLOWING GUIDELINES FOR THE ENJOYMENT AND CONSIDERATION OF ALL!

All roads are one-way except the main entrance. The speed limit is 5 MPH and is strictly enforced, and please stop at all stop signs. Please keep all vehicles and campers on the gravel roads, and *please do not drive on the grass due to the muddy surfaces.*

**Hide-A-Way Campsites prides itself as a quiet campground. Loud campers will not be tolerated and will be asked to leave without a refund.**

### General

- Check-in time is 1:00 PM Check-out time is 11:00 AM. All campers must be checked in and at your site before dark.
- Quiet Time is from 10:00 PM to 8:00 AM. All children must be back at their campsite by 9:00 PM.
- Basketball, volleyball, horseshoes, and other games are available for check-out. Please use the sign-out sheet at the store.
- A dumpster is located across from the store and shall only be used for household waste accumulated from within the campground. No bulky items or hazardous waste are allowed.
- Please accompany your children 6 years old or younger while they are enjoying the campground.
- All children under the age of 14 must wear an approved bicycle helmet per New York State Law.
- Hiking trails are for foot traffic only. **Bicycles or Motorized vehicles are not allowed on the hiking trails.**
- Two cars are allowed per site, all others must park in an area designated by the office at check-in.
- Golf carts are not allowed in the campground.
- Electric bikes and scooters must follow the 5 MPH speed limit.
- All alcohol must be consumed responsibly. If there are any concerns with disorderly conduct or drunkenness, all parties connected will be required to leave without a refund.
- The pond is for fishing (catch and release only), no swimming or boats are allowed.
- No firearms, fireworks of any type, or illegal drugs are allowed on the campground property.
- Please do not use your grill on the plastic tables without protection, they will melt. Ask us for some protection if needed.

### Visitors

- Maximum of 2 adults, 3 children, or 4 adults are permitted.
- All visitors must register at the camp store and pay the visitor's fee before going to a campsite.
- Registered site occupants are fully responsible and liable for the actions of all their visitors.
- Daily visitor fees are \$7.00 from the hours of 9 am to 9:30 pm. An additional fee of \$8.00 will be charged for overnight visitors good through 10 am the next morning. Children 5 and under are free.
- No Visitors shall enter the campground before 9:00 AM or after 7:00 PM.
- Visitors may not bring any animals into the campground.

### Pets

- You must provide a valid rabies certificate at check-in for each dog.
- A maximum of 3 dogs is allowed.
- Barking dogs will not be tolerated. Nuisance dogs will be asked to leave.
- Dogs must be on a 6' maximum leash and accompanied by an adult at all times.
- No dogs are allowed in the store, Rec Hall, or pool area.
- Dog(s) shall not be left unattended at any time in the campground.
- You must clean up after your pet.
- **Please dispose of pet fur in the trash when grooming your dogs, do not leave it on your site.**

## Firewood

We would prefer that you do not bring firewood into the campground because of the vast destruction of our trees which has occurred in the past due to invasive species in wood. There is firewood available for purchase for a very reasonable price.

- If you must bring firewood, Hide-a-Way Campsites follows DEC rules regarding the transportation of firewood. Firewood can only be brought into the campground if it originates within a 50-mile radius of the campground and you are not crossing any state lines.
- You must have a DEC "Self-Issued Certificate of Origin" filled out upon arrival. Self-Issued Certificate of Origin are available on the DEC website. <https://dec.ny.gov/nature/animals-fish-plants/invasive-species/terrestrial/firewood>
- Any firewood brought in which is not within the above guidelines shall be removed immediately from the grounds.
- Campfires must be extinguished before leaving your site or before returning to your camper for the night.

## Pool

- **NO LIFEGUARDS ARE ON DUTY. SWIMMING IS AT YOUR OWN RISK. NO DIVING ALLOWED.**
- Pool hours are 10:00 AM to 7:00 PM.
- No food, alcohol, or glass containers are allowed in the pool area.
- **NY State Law Requirement:** All campers and their guests must sign a waiver at the camp store before using the pool; then use the daily sign-in sheet for each use, posted at the pool entrance gate.
- Never swim alone, A MINIMUM of (2) CAPABLE adults, 18 years of age or older must be present whenever the swimming facility is in use, with at least (1) CAPABLE adult on the pool deck at all times.
- There is no substitute for adequate supervision. Children under the age of 18 must be accompanied to the pool by two CAPABLE parents or guardians responsible for their safety and behavior.
- The pool will be closed at the management's discretion during inclement weather or emergencies.

Hide-A-Way Campsites reserves the right to evict any person or person(s), who in our opinion is violating the guidelines, vandalizing, creating a disturbance, damaging property, etc. without a refund.

**In any emergency, notify the office or an employee immediately. The RING doorbell located at the office will ring on all manager's cell phones. If you are unable to contact an employee, call 911 immediately.**
